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ANNUAL REPORT-ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021

I am pleased to present the annual report for the academic year 2020-2021 of Loyola Institute of Technology. Since its inception in 2003, our institution has been committed to offering high-quality education to young and aspiring students. Our motto, "Fully Alive and Fully Human," reflects our dedication to nurturing holistic development. Throughout this academic year, the college has seen significant developmental activities. These initiatives have aimed to enhance various aspects of our institution, ensuring an enriching experience for our students and faculty members alike.

The academic activities of the college for the academic year 2020-2021 began on 12th of August, 2020. A total number of 233 students were admitted for all the 5 Undergraduate and 1 Postgraduate disciplines.

We have conducted 3 value added courses for the enhancement of the student knowledge in which 511 students got benefitted. This enabled the students to enrich their subject competency and expertise in their desired discipline. Mentor mentee system plays a vital role in grooming the students for a better future. In order to see the progress in the performance of the students, we organize Student Academic Council meetings frequently.

For effective learning, Loyola Institute of Technology has a built-up area of 25876.54 sq. m with a library, Eight computer labs, Eight seminar halls, restrooms in all floors and well-furnished staff rooms.

All the classrooms are well furnished with desks, green ceramic boards, pinup boards and five fans. The library is well established and spacious with 1100 sq. m. The library provides DELNET, E-Books, E-Journals, etc. It also functions with technical facilities like Bar Coding system, OPAC and high-tech digital library with NDL, TNDL, DOAJ and IEI.

Our management has been encouraging the meritorious, sports excellent and economically downtrodden students by means of awarding scholarships at the time of admission in terms of fee waving. 1191 students were benefited out of 1328 students (89.68%) with management scholarships of Rs.35,09,000. Moreover, students benefited from various government bodies receiving scholarships of Rs.4,17,36,300.





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Loyola Institute of Technology provides a platform for each and every student to showcase their talent, organizational skills and work in a team. Students gain exposures through supporting cells and clubs. Our college encourages co-curricular and extra -curricular activities for holistic development of our students. 1094 students were benefited by the guidance for competitive exams and career counseling offered by the institution.

In order to nurture patriotism in students' minds, our college celebrates Republic Day every year. Engineers day was organized online. Loyola Institute of Technology Celebrated Women's Day Program by conducting various programs. All lady faculty participated in sports conducted for women's day and gifts and Tree saplings were presented to the Inspector and Sub Inspectors in Nazarathpet Police station.

The students learn about culture and tradition of the other places and gain knowledge about the important movement of arts and architecture through educational tours. Students were regularly taken to various factories.

Students participated in about 18 sports and culture events. Our sports team outshined in all the games and brought laurels for their distinguished performance and proved their success. 3 extension and outreach programs were conducted in collaboration with industries, schools, etc. 14 workshops, seminars, conferences relating to research methodology, IPR and entrepreneurship were conducted during the academic year 2020-21. Alumni students, parents, teachers and employers feedback are collected regularly for institutional development every year.

116 full-time teachers were on roll during this academic year 2020-21. All the faculty members were encouraged to pursue Doctoral Degrees and published articles in reputed journals. Total 74 faculty members have attended faculty development programs in various colleges and 9 non-teaching staff members attended administrative training programs conducted by our college. Faculty members were provided with financial support for attending conferences, workshops, etc. 60 faculty attended various programs with financial support of Rs. 3,14,950 in this academic year. Rs. 4,65,000 was received by our faculty members from non-governmental agencies as grant for research projects. Total 15 research papers have been published. Rs.66,59,287 was spent for Infrastructure Augmentation and Rs. 25,58,824 was spent on Infrastructure Maintenance.
